SUBJECT: POLICE TRIAL DISPOSITIONS

The following dispositions were rendered by a triumvirate consisting of Captain Gary S. Prystauk, Captain Brian E. Caven, and Captain George Green. These matters were adjudicated on August 11, 1999.

SERGEANT IRVING BRADLEY, PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE SECTION, ADMINISTRATION BUREAU  
CAP# 98-706 - IOP# 98-811

CHARGE I: Violation of Newark Police Department Rules and Regulations, Chapter 6:24  
--CRIMINAL LAW-- Department members shall not violate any criminal laws, any provisions of the Disorderly Persons Act or of the City Ordinances. They shall commit no illegal act.

CHARGE I-B: Violation of Civil Service Rule 4A:2-2.3(a)5.

An employee may be subject to discipline for:

5. Conviction of a Crime

SPECIFICATION: On October 15, 1998, Sergeant Irving Bradley Jr. was indicted by the Union County Grand Jury for:

N.J.S.A. 2C:29-2(b).....ELUDING AN OFFICER (SECOND DEGREE)

N.J.S.A. 2C:12-1(b).....AGGRAVATED ASSAULT (THIRD DEGREE)

N.J.S.A. 2C:29-2(a).....RESISTING ARREST (FOURTH DEGREE)

CHARGE II: Violation of Newark Police Department Rules and Regulations, Chapter 6:9.2  
--ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES - OFF DUTY-- Department members while off duty shall not drink alcoholic beverages to an extent which renders them unfit to call for duty.

CHARGE III: Violation of Newark Police Department Rules and Regulations, Chapter 3:1.1 --CONDUCT IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE-- Police Officers in both private and public lives shall conduct themselves so as to avoid impugning the reputation of the Department. They shall maintain the dignity and integrity of their Office through the exemplary obedience to all Rules and Regulations; the maintenance of respect for the welfare and rights of all citizens; the courteous and objective enforcement of laws without favor or prejudice, and the recognition that police service is a public trust requiring dedication to ideals and ethics of the highest degree.  
(2 counts)

CHARGE III-B: Violation of Civil Service Rule 4A:2-2.3(a)6.

An employee may be subject to discipline for:

6. Conduct Unbecoming a Public Employee

SPECIFICATION I: On May 30, 1998, at approximately 12:15 a.m., Sergeant Irving Bradley Jr., did conduct himself in such a manner as to engender discredit, ridicule and criticism to the Department, in that he was operating a Newark Police Department unmarked unit while intoxicated. He was arrested by members of the Rahway Police Department and refused to submit to a breathalyzer test. As a result, Sergeant Irving Bradley Jr, was issued two summonses — 1. Driving While Intoxicated and 2. Refusing to Submit to a Breathalyzer Test.

SPECIFICATION II: On May 30, 1998, at approximately 12:15 a.m., Sergeant Irving Bradley Jr., did conduct himself in such a manner as to engender discredit, ridicule and criticism to the Department, in that while being detained by members of the Rahway Police department, he became uncooperative and drive away. A pursuit ensued, and once apprehended at 1941 Rutherford Street, Rahway, Sergeant Irving Bradley Jr., resisted arrest. As a result, Sergeant Irving Bradley Jr., was arrested for: Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer, Resisting Arrest, Obstructing the Administration of Law, and Eluding Police.

PLEA: GUILTY


DISPOSITION: GUILTY

PENALTY: SUSPENDED FROM DUTY FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS WITHOUT PAY.  
ONE (1) YEAR PROBATION - MUST NOT BECOME INVOLVED IN ALCOHOL RELATED INCIDENTS. MUST ATTEND ALCOHOL COUNSELLING AND PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION TO INTERNAL AFFAIRS BUREAU. MUST NOT OPERATE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES UNTIL DRIVER LICENSE HAS BEEN RESTORED.
